CONTENT (PROGRAMMING/CURATING)

We are committed to:

- Creating a cultural offer that promotes community cohesion and widens engagement in the arts and arts practice.
- Producing and collaborating with local, national and international artists, producers and agencies to create programmes of work that deliver against the key priorities of LGCHF.

- Delivering content that is not intended to be harmful or controversial. However, whilst we carefully brief our artist and performers, we cannot censor or control a live performance

QUALITY/EXCELLENCE
