Sir,

Reference the planning application for extensions to 20 Woolston Avenue, Letchworth Garden city under reference 37270 and your letter dated 13th May 2021. The extensions involve a single storey rear extension and a first floor front

extension above the existing garage. I have no objection to the first floor extension above the garage, but I have a concern about the single storey extension.

I am concerned about the proposed single storey extension. The plans show that the extension stretches 6m out from the existing house towards my property. However, the plans do not show the distance between the end of the extension and the dividing fence between our properties. In addition, there is quite a large Leylandii hedge (I estimate 5.5m high and nearly 2m deep) along this fence on my neighbour's side. If this hedge was removed in order to facilitate the proposed extension, then there would be a risk of being overlooked by the window in the extension, as well as an increased noise level.

Please consider the above points before reaching a decision on the proposal.
